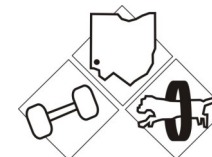

SCHEDULE

These trials each day will be run concurrently, which means, a dog entered in both tests would be allowed to complete both runs in succession (back to back) without having to wait for one event to finish before the next can begin. A list will be issued after closing with times each dog should be available for running. There will be max 10 dogs/group. **Once your 2 runs are completed, it is recommended that you leave premises.** If you enter more than 1 dog, please advise if you want to be in same group or different groups. You may note if you prefer a morning or afternoon run time, and we will do our best to accommodate all requests.

Trial Hours: 8:00 am until completed each day
Roll Call / Inspection / Briefing: **Only arrive 15 minutes prior to your assigned run time. No on-site briefing. Will be emailed to you.**

INSPECTION:

All dogs will be inspected for soundness (measured if necessary) prior to running each event. All bitches will be checked for being in-season prior to running each event. **All inspections will be performed by owners/handlers. It is advised to bring your own tissue if you have a bitch!**

ENTRY LIMITS, FEES, AND INSTRUCTIONS

Limit each day - 160 dogs.

Entry Fees before closing: \$20.00 per dog per trial
If using Paypal * \$21.00 per dog per trial
Entry Fees after closing, if space allows: \$30.00 per dog per trial
If using Paypal * \$31.00 per dog per trial
(all fees already include the \$3.50 AKC recording fee)

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS *** PLEASE READ ***

Send completed entry forms with correct fees to Katie Maess, 8872 Snider Road, Mason, OH 45040. Entry forms MUST be signed. Entries unsigned will NOT be accepted. Postdated checks will not be accepted. Please circle which class (under 12", 12"- under 18", 18" & over). **Make checks or money orders payable to HDTC.** Confirmations will be emailed.

*** An entry form must still be mailed in if using Paypal to pay for entry fees. A \$1 non-refundable service fee is assessed per entry.**

PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE --- print legibly on the entry form (especially email). Include cell phone number.

The term "dog" means either dog or bitch.

By entering these tests, exhibitor agrees to hold the host club (HDTC) and event site (K9 Splash Zone) harmless. HDTC does not agree to arbitration as noted on AKC entry form.

Any exhibitor whose bitch has come in season, or any dog which has occurred an injury, after the closing date may obtain a refund of his entry fee (less \$6.00 for admin. expenses per entry) upon presentation of a Veterinarian's certificate to the Show Secretary prior to the start of the trial. NOTE: There will not be any refunds of entries AFTER closing date except for above reason. No refunds on overpayments of \$6.00 or less.

Bounced checks are subject to a fee of \$30.00.

Course is fully enclosed with fencing. Please bring your own chairs and shade.

NO food nor beverages will be available at the trial. Please bring your own.

COVID-19 PROCEDURES are printed in red through-out this premium. Everyone is expected to follow State of Ohio procedures in effect at time of event. This includes social distancing of at least 6 feet. All exhibitors will be spaced at least 6 feet apart when lining up to run.

Dogs will be scheduled in blocks for each hour. Only arrive 15 minutes prior to your scheduled time block for check-in & inspection. Instructions will be included on your final confirmation.

TESTS, TITLES & TIMING

How does a FAST CAT work?

- 1) Fast CAT is a timed straight race of 100 yards.
- 2) Dogs run singularly.
- 3) The dog's time to complete the 100 yard dash is converted into mph.
- 4) A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at the withers:
 - 18" or greater = handicap is 1.0
 - 12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5
 - Below 12" = handicap is 2.0
- 5) Points = MPH multiplied by the dog's handicap
- 6) FAST CAT suffix titles are earned at designated milestones:
 - BCAT = 150 points
 - DCAT = 500 points
 - FCAT = 1,000 points
 - FCAT# = each additional 500 points
- 7) Timing devices: The time to complete the 100 yard dash is recorded to the nearest 1/100th of a second (e.g. 9.11). The club may use break-the-beam equipment to obtain the time. If stopwatches are used, there shall be two timers positioned at the finish line. An individual at the start line shall signal with an arm drop the moment the nose of the dog crosses the start line. The timers shall stop their watches when the nose of the dog crosses the finish line. The times from the two stop watches shall be averaged to determine the recorded time.
- 8) Conversion: $204.545 / \text{Dog's Time} = \text{MPH}$

GENERAL RULES

- 1) All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the test.
- 2) Each entry will be examined and may be measured with a wicket at inspection. If in the opinion of the inspection committee, any entry found to be lame, unfit to compete, or a female in season, shall not be allowed to enter and entry fees shall be refunded. The decision of the field committee is final.
- 3) Muzzles are allowed. Dogs may wear any type of collar except no pinch collars, and no electronic training collars or devices are allowed. The club recommends using a plain collar and lead, and we discourage the use of flexi leads for safety reasons.
- 4) Electric continuous loop machines will be used. Lures consist of white plastic bags.
- 5) The field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.
- 6) There will be a \$5 fine assessed for any loose dog not taking part in the course in progress (per AKC).
- 7) The following actions may result in a fine and/or being excused from the event: exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct, not picking up after one's dog, or littering in any area of the event.
- 8) NO ONE is allowed on the field without the express permission of the Field Chairman, except the appointed Field Committee.
- 9) There is NO SMOKING in the following areas: In and around the Paddock area, in and around the Secretary's table, and nowhere on the field itself. Please be respectful of others.
- 10) **NOTE: There are port-a-pottys to use. It is recommended to bring your own toilet paper and sanitary wipes to wipe area after you are finished. This will help eliminate cross-contamination.**
- 11) **RECOMMENDED to wear face masks when in close proximity of others (check in, release area, catch area). Also to wear gloves in these areas. Can use poop bags to open gates/doors.**
- 12) **RECOMMENDED to bring your own hand sanitizer, disinfectants, and wipes to avoid any cross-contamination.**
- 13) **Park with sufficient distance between vehicles.**
- 14) **NO Food Vendors will be on-site. Bring your own food, water, etc.**
- 15) **If you are sick, please do not come. Full refunds (less paypal fees) will be issued. Trial Secretary must be notified before Trials begin.**

RIBBONS / ROSETTES

A light blue qualifying ribbon will be awarded to each dog successfully passing. These will be available at end of each block of time.

New Title Rosettes will be awarded to each dog completing a BCAT, DCAT, or FCAT Title at Hamilton Dog Training Club's Trials !!
