SCHEDULE

These trials each day will be run concurrently, which means, a dog entered in both tests on same day would be allowed to complete both runs in succession (back to back) without having to wait for one event to finish before the next can begin. A running list will be issued after closing. Once your 2 runs are completed, it is recommended that you leave premises. If you enter more than 1 dog, please be advised they will be scheduled in concurrent time slots. **Online entries only may choose a preferred time block.**

Trial Hours: 9:00 am until completed each day
** may change based on actual number of entries received*

Roll Call / Inspection: **Only arrive a half hour prior to your assigned run time. No on-site briefing. Will be emailed to you.**

INSPECTION:

All dogs will be inspected for soundness (measured if necessary) prior to running each event. All bitches will be checked for being in-season prior to running each event. **All inspections will be performed by owners/handlers. Please bring your own tissue if you have a bitch!**

ENTRY LIMITS, FEES, AND INSTRUCTIONS

Limit each day - 160 dogs.

Entry Fees before closing, if mailing: \$20.00 per dog per trial
If paying online * \$21.25 per dog per trial
Entry Fees after closing, if space allows: \$25.00 per dog per trial
(all fees already include the \$3.50 AKC recording fee)
Fun Runs (as time permits) : \$ 5.00 per run

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS *** PLEASE READ ***

If entering via mail, send completed entry forms with correct fees to Katie Maess, 8872 Snider Road, Mason, OH 45040. Entry forms MUST be signed. Entries unsigned will NOT be accepted. Postdated checks will not be accepted. Please **circle which class (under 12", 12"- under 18", 18" & over)**. Make checks or money orders payable to HDTTC. Confirmations will be emailed at closing date.

* If entering online to pay for entry fees, a \$1 non-refundable service fee is assessed per entry.

The term "dog" means either dog or bitch.

By entering these tests, exhibitor agrees to hold the host club (HDTTC) and event site (K9 Splash Zone) harmless. HDTTC does not agree to arbitration as noted on AKC entry form.

Any exhibitor whose bitch has come in season, or any dog which has occurred an injury, after the closing date may obtain a refund of his entry fee (less \$5.00 for **admin. expenses per entry**) upon presentation of a **Veterinarian's certificate to the Show Secretary** prior to the start of the trial. NOTE: There will not be any refunds of entries AFTER closing date except for above reason. No refunds on overpayments of \$5.00 or less. No refunds of paypal fees.

Bounced checks are subject to a fee of \$30.00.

Course is fully enclosed with fencing. Please bring your own chairs and shade.

Dogs will be scheduled 10 dogs per half hour time blocks. Only arrive a half prior to your scheduled time block for check-in & inspection. Instructions will be included on your final confirmation. Starting & ending time each day will be dependent on actual entries received. Running order will be emailed out once pre-entries close. We will try to accommodate all requested time slots -- no guarantees.

TESTS, TITLES & TIMING

How does a FAST CAT work?

- 1) Fast CAT is a timed straight race of 100 yards.
- 2) Dogs run singularly.
- 3) **The dog's time to complete the 100 yard dash is converted into mph.**
- 4) **A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points earned.** The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at the withers:
 - 18" or greater = handicap is 1.0**
 - 12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5**
 - Below 12" = handicap is 2.0**
- 5) **Points = MPH multiplied by the dog's handicap**
- 6) FAST CAT suffix titles are earned at designated milestones:
 - BCAT = 150 points
 - DCAT = 500 points
 - FCAT = 1,000 points
 - FCAT# = each additional 500 points
- 7) Timing devices: The time to complete the 100 yard dash is recorded to the nearest 1/100th of a second (e.g. 9.11). The club may use break-the-beam equipment to obtain the time. If stopwatches are used, there shall be two timers positioned at the finish line. An individual at the start line shall signal with an arm drop the moment the nose of the dog crosses the start line. The timers shall stop their watches when the nose of the dog crosses the finish line. The times from the two stop watches shall be averaged to determine the recorded time.
- 8) Conversion: $204.545 / \text{Dog's Time} = \text{MPH}$

GENERAL RULES

- 1) All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the test.
- 2) Each entry will be examined and may be measured with a wicket at inspection. If in the opinion of the inspection committee, any entry found to be lame, unfit to compete, or a female in season, shall not be allowed to enter and entry fees shall be refunded (less paypal fees if paid online). The decision of the field committee is final.
- 3) Muzzles are allowed. Dogs may wear any type of collar except no pinch collars, and no electronic training collars or devices are allowed. The club recommends using a plain collar and lead, and we discourage the use of flexi leads for safety reasons.
- 4) Electric continuous loop machines will be used. Lures consist of white plastic bags.
- 5) Electronic timers will be used.
- 6) The field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.
- 7) There will be a \$5 fine assessed for any loose dog not taking part in the course in progress (per AKC).
- 8) The following actions may result in a fine and/or being excused from the event: exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct, not picking up after your dog, or littering in any area of the event.
- 9) NO ONE is allowed on the field without the express permission of the Field Chairman, except the appointed Field Committee.
- 10) There is NO SMOKING in the following areas: In and around the Paddock area, in and around the Secretary's table, and nowhere on the field itself. Please be respectful of others.
- 11) There are port-a-pottys to use. .
- 12) Park with sufficient distance between vehicles. If it is wet outside, do NOT park on any of the grassy areas. There is plenty of parking on gravel.
- 13) Suggested to bring your own food, water, shade cover. etc.

RIBBONS / ROSETTES

A light blue qualifying ribbon will be awarded to each dog successfully passing. These will be available at end of each block of time.

New Title Rosettes will be awarded to each dog completing a BCAT, DCAT, or FCAT Title at Hamilton Dog Training Club's Trials !!
